Introduction.


Social media can create a connection in many different ways like joining and connecting like minded people together with a common interest, showcasing our member's philatelic items, introducing new people to the hobby and importantly creating a digital presence/ archive for BPS to show we are an active philatelic society and community. Brighton Philatelic has recently begun to actively use Facebook and Instagram social media sites to create awareness of the group to a wider audience and importantly a younger audience. To date we have received strong interest from other social media sites and individuals around the globe.

Firstly to cover some of the common terms used with social media. A social media account on Facebook (FB) and Instagram (Insta) is called a 'page or profile' and any 'content' (pictures etc) uploaded is called a 'post'. A 'follower' is someone who has pressed the 'Follow" icon and then the BPS page will appear in their 'Feed' (pages that person follows) and new content that is posted will come up when they open their device and scroll. "Likes" are when someone likes the content posted and also comments can be left but remember this is a public forum and all comments can be seen. BPS Facebook and Instagram pages can be found by simply searching on the search "Q" icon the name Brighton Philatelic Society then press follow or Like. If having difficulties finding the page or setting up an account there are members who can help.

How to Access Facebook and "Like" or "Comment" on a post



Facebook can be accessed via multiple medias:



The following screens/instructions assume you are using a computer. For Phones/Tablets, you will be required to download the Facebook "app".


To access via computer goto Facebook via the link from Brighton Philatelic Society's web page (above) or else go directly to https://www.facebook.com/. The following screen will appear




If you go directly to Facebook (without the link from BPS website) you will need to find Facebook's Brighton Philatelic "page". To do this, goto the Search function (highlighted above in Yellow) and type in Brighton Philatelic




To see posts that have been made, goto option "Posts" (highlighted below):



You will then see a number of posts that can be selected and read:




If you like what you have read, you can hit the button "Like" and it will record that you have seen and like the post.




Note that if you regularly "Like" a post from Brighton Philatelic, then new posts will appear in your Facebook account when you access it.


If you would like to make a comment on the post, hit the button "Comment". Once you select this, another field will open up below for your comments to be added in.



Now type in your comments. Once finished, hit the "enter" key.



Everyone will now have access to view your comments.



You can use the comments as a way of interacting with other like-minded people (members and non-members of BPS) for a specific topic.
